SPRING TOUR - SUNDAY 20th May 1979

Permission has now been obtained for us to visit Lincolnshire and arrangements are well in hand for this tour. Basically the programme is:- depart Bradford(Interchange) 9.15 am, Leeds (Vicar Lane) 9.45 am, then via the Motorways to Scunthorpe to see the wide variety of stock operated there by Lincolnshire, thence to Lincoln where the lunch break will be taken, the Bracebridge Heath works will be visited and, we hope, the Lincoln Corporation depot, before the rest of the afternoon and tea break is taken at the Lincolnshire Vintage Vehicle Society premises. Our visit coincides with the LWS Open Day, so a number of interesting vehicles are likely to be making an appearance. After tea, the return will be direct to Leeds (8pm approx) and Bradford(8.30pm approx). Fare is likely to be £2 to £2.50. Vehicle has yet to be decided and depends on the cost and support received. GENERAL NEWS

The York "Open Topper", 3967, which lost its roof on 2nd February as reported last month, travelled down to Lowestoft on Sunday 4th February for a new roof to be fitted. By 27th February it was back at Grove Park with a brown roof, and then went into the Bodyshop to be finished off ready for service. It was back in service by early March.

1481 had a new engine fitted by United Automobile for York Depot during their recent troubles. 1449 currently has two front fleet numbers - one in the old standard position and the other in the centre of the white band. At the rear the fleet number is in the old position rather than in the centre of the white band.

ADVERTISEMENT NEWS

1449, at least, now appears to have lost its National all-round advertising (either intentionally or otherwise, since these paper adverts were rapidly deteriorating in appearance and legibility). 1450 was a further vehicle with this advertisement.

At Leeds, the shortage of vehicles resulted in a number of journeys being withdrawn on Monday to Friday from 22nd February until further notice. Journeys affected are:-

Route 36 - 0725 Leeds-Harrogate; (0810 Harrogate - Bilton (11); 0823 Bilton-Harrogate(11), 0835, 1035, 1235, 1435, 1635 Harrogate-Leeds, 1130, 1330, 1530 Leeds-Harrogate (all the above is car 12); 1630 Leeds-Harrogate, 1735 Harrogate-Leeds (car 43).

Route 43 0725 Wellington St-York, 0925 York-Wellington Street (Car 5 - a regular Ribbles working during February).

Route X84 - 1605 Leeds-Yeadon Airport; 1640 Airport-Leeds(car 11); 1805 Leeds-Airport; 1840 Airport-Leeds(car 3).

Route 655/755 0700 Leeds-Avro Car 42)

Journeys shown above in brackets do not appear on the Company's hand-out, but are the preceding/following journeys on the rota and by implication are also probably withdrawn. It is, however, possible that these journeys have been covered from other rotas.

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Harrogate On 16/2, 1068 (H) was on Harrogate-Tadcaster(78) as was 1235 (H) on 19/2. On 20/2, 1314 (YK loan H) and 2560 (H) were both on Harrogate-Scarborough (84). On 10/2, 1309 (H) was on 11/11A. 1318, seen on tow through Pannal on 30/1, is back in service.

Leeds On 28/2, 1058 was on the 1830 Ilkley-Leeds(733). Working on Leeds-Scarborough (43) have been 1005 (YK) on 1/2; 3457 (YK) on 8/2; 1447 (L) on 10/2; 1440 (L) on 11/2 and 1004 (YK) on 14/2. On Leeds-York (43/43A) have been 1049 (L) on 6 and 9/2. 2319 (L) on 7 and 14/2 and 1056(L) on 8/2. On Leeds-Bridlington (44) have been 1441 (L) on 5/2, 1273 (L) on 7/2, 1441 (L) on 20/2 and EYMS 883 (loan L) on 27/2. On 21/1, 1710 (K loan L) was on 1715 Leeds-Tadcaster (742); on 16/2, 1465 (SK loan L) was on this route as was 1210 (CRW loan L) on 23/2. On 8/2, 2516 (L) was on Leeds-Aberford (748). On 2/2, 1058 (L) was on Leeds-Scholes(749), as was 1046 (L) on 9/2.

Malton Malton depot have used the following vehicles on Leeds-Scarborough (43)-1003/155/268/335/403 (all M), 1267/97/8/313/45/79/1/2/97/401 and 3331. 3331 was used on various days from 26/1 until 7/2. 1003 usually appears on Sunday, being the car on 92 during the week. 1155 was on the 1710 Scarborough-Leeds on 17/2 whilst 1066 (YK) was on the 1335 Leeds-Scarborough, which is covered by York (two men) on Saturdays. Since the vehicle never appeared again working with a Malton driver it is doubtful whether this vehicle actually garaged at Malton. 1339 has once or twice during the month appeared on Malton Car 5 which works into Tadcaster on 87 then Boston Spa and Tadcaster school special and finally the 1715 Leeds-Malton journey. On 26/2, 1209 (CRW loan M) was on the 1835 Leeds-Scarborough (43).

Wetherby The reference to a Leeds depot turn on route 79, the 1735 from York (St. Leonards) on M-F is actually a Wetherby duty, part of car 1 which works 1600 Toulston Lodge-Terry's (204), 1633 Terry's-St. Leonards (J), 1645 Terry's-Rowntree's (-); 1703 Rowntress-Wigginton (20 dup); 1720 Wigginton-St. Leonards(-); 1735 St. Leonards-Wetherby (79).

York On 2/2 the 1635 to Harrogate (84) which is a crew turn was worked by 2303 (YK). 3836 was working on Y12/20 on 7/2, these routes being almost wholly VR operated. On 14/2, 3452 was on Y2. 2335 (K loan YK) was noted on a local service (either Y2 or Y12) between Acomb and Station at 0810 on 15/2. Later the same day the severe blizzard so disrupted services that once again Town services were only operating to and from station or Rougier St and all services had ceased owing to the appalling road conditions by 1900 hrs. On the following morning (16/2), no school specials were operated in the city so that all available vehicles could maintain scheduled services. Noted on Y2 on 16/2 was 1043(YK). 1339 (M loan YK) was on Y13 on 21/2, whilst 1043 was on this route on 22/2. On 24/2, an unusual vehicle on Y11A/21 was 3175. 1339 (M loan YK) was working the Sunday journeys on 46 York-Hull on 25/2 showing '46p' instead of the correct '46C'. On 26/2, the 1610 to Copmanthorpe (Y15) was worked by 3832, it is not known whether this is a regular DD duty or not. On 28/2 single deckers were again in evidence on town services with 3329 on Y12/20 1356 on Y1/8 and 1209 on Y2. On 24/2, 1057(YK) worked York-Tadcaster(Woodlands Ave) (43). On 17/2 and 24/2, 1165(YK) was on Y1/8. On 20/2, 1375 (H loan L) was on Y11A and 21. On 1/2, 1338 was on Y13. On 5/2, 1371 was on 82, 1004 on 83B and 1005 on 80. On 7/2, 1440 was on 43, 1375 on 84 and 1005 on Y13. The following day 1403 was on Y13, 3830 on 79 and 1375 on 84. On 9/2, 1209 was on Y9, 2320 on Y11A, 1481 on Y13, 3458 on 84, 1288 on 79 and 1489 on 84. On 12/2, 1255 was on 84.

On 13/2, 1397 was on Y13, 1209 on Y9 and 3830 on Y8. On 14/2, 1314 was on Y13, 1420 on 43 to Bradford and 3833 on 79. On 15/2, 1004 was on Y2 and 1267 on Y9. On 16/2, 1153 was on Y1 and 1366 on the 1725 York-Leeds(43A). On 19/2, 1378 was on Y9 and 1209 on Y19. On 20/2, 3430 was on Y13 and 1155 on Y24. On 21/2, 1489 was on 84, 3175 on Y13 and 3430 on Y15. On 22/2, 1339 was on Y13 and 3433 on Y14B. On 23/2, 3457 was on Y13 as was 1356. On 24/2 3961 was on Y3 and 3798 on Y19. On 26/2, 1439 was on 84 and 1005 was on Y9. The following day 1314 was on Y13 and 1371 on 80. The last day of the month saw 3461 on Y2, 1401 on Y13 and 1356 on 84. On 17/2, 1042/89, 1005 and 1371 were all on Y9. On 24/2, 1057 worked OMO on Y14 and 1209 was on Y9. On 17/2, 1209 was on Y19. 1089/90 have been very noticeable during the shortage on many duties although the indicators do not often give away their secrets. 1089 has worked on 82 on a few occasions recently and they have also been on Works/School Specials. On 18/2, 1001 (H loan YK) was in Toft Green showing "Y13A/Rougier Street". 1004/5 have been regular performers on Y9/19 particularly in the evening. A contrast on 26/2 was 1209 on 84 to Scarborough passing 1058 on 43 Scarborough-Leeds. 1179 (SK) was noted heading for York Depot at 2020 on 19/2, showing "84/York". "New" LHs are not often seen in York. 1042 or 1054 worked Y12B into York at 0815 on 1/3.

Space permitting, the rotas for the duties shown above will be included at the end of this issue, but it should be noted that each vehicle was only seen on the part of the rota shown above and did not necessarily work the full duty.

6. TEN YEARS AGO

A large number of vehicles had entered service on 1st March 1969 - VR 13<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>/5/22 at Bradford, VR 16/7/8/23 at Leeds, VR 19/20/1 at Otley, KVR 25/6 at Keighley and YVR 27/9/30/1/2 at York. As might be expected, these had replaced a number of earlier vehicles including the last KSWs. Those affected were SMG 39/40/3/5, SUG28/30/6, YDG 84/7/8/90/2 KDB 54/6, DBW 29, and DGW 2/3/10. This had resulted in 33 vehicles being held awaiting disposal.

At Leeds, most of the ex Ledgard AECs and Daimlers had appeared on the new Otley-Leeds services. DGW 4 on its last day of service had been on Leeds-Otley (34) and Leeds-Scholes (48).

The passengers on the 1105 Leeds-Bridlington (44) on February 16th had an eventful journey. SRG 65 worked from Wellington Street to Vicar Lane; SRG 49 from Vicar Lane to York Depot; EYMS 863 from York Depot to Driffield and SRG 58 (sc) from Driffield to Bridlington - four vehicles in all! This was due to SRG 58 (Sc) being replaced at Driffield on the previous day by East Yorkshire 863. On the return trip, SRG 58 worked Bridlington-York and SRG 49 York-Leeds.

On their last day of service, February 28th, YDG 90 worked on Y4/4A and YDG 92 on Y2. YDG 84/7 were in the depot showing "Blank" front and rear. The new double deckers were booked out as follows for 1st March - two on Y2 and three on Y10. This is to avoid Coppergate and Piccadilly roundabout and Rougier Street.
