All were delivered as usual with no fleetnames, but with legal ownership, unladen weight and small fleet numbers above the fuel filler. 1747 was prepared for service by 30th June and was taken to 0they on that date on Trade Plates 60% WT. 1748 was also at Otley ready to enter service on 1st July, but 1750 was not delivered to Bradford until lunchtime on the 1st. The "using up" of the last of 10 registration numbers on 1747 will be noted; the first (2350, JUB 641V) entered service on 5th October last year.

The unladen weight of learner bus 4068 after its conversion is 7-13-0.

The different tail lights fitted to recent deliveries appear to be the same design as those fitted to last year's Plaxton vehicles. As such they probably incorporate high intensity rear warning lights for use in fog etc, to comply with new regulations.

There have been a number of service changes brought into effect during June. On 6th June, alterations were made in York. Services 9, 12, 15, 21, 22/22B, 43, 54 and 82 had timetable changes. Service 10 now operates a circular route in Haxby and buses operate in alternate directions. Journeys operating via Haxby, village are numbered 10A. Service 11 continued to a new terminus at Grassholme but due to complaints by residents this was temporarily suspended after 21st June and the old route and terminus were resumed. Service 20A journeys terminating at Haxby are diverted in off peak periods to omit Calf Close. These journeys operate by way of Usher Lane, Ozken Grove and Moor Lane. A new service, 30/30A, has been introduced between the City and Haxby/Wigginton. It operates

between the peak periods and serves the Greenshaw Drive area of Haxby, terminating at Calf Close. During Monday to Friday peak periods, some existing journeys on Service 20 are diverted by way of Greenshaw Drive as route 30.

From 22nd June major changes took place at the western side of the Company's area. In Yeadon, Otley, Ilkley, Harrogate areas, new timetables were introduced on services 650, 651, 653, 654, 674, 675 with minor changes to 775, 776, 777. A new service is 652 (Otley-Bradford via Frizinghall Road and Manningham Lane) whilst 654 is diverted to serve Frizinghall Road. X63 is withdrawn and at least partly replaced by a journey on 650 from Ilkley to Greengates. At Keighley from the same date, a new timetable was introduced on 706, 714, 715 and 726.

It was in Bradford where most change took place on 22nd June, however, West Yorkshire operated services 690, 691 and X67 were withdrawn and in addition, West Yorkshire lose their share of operations on services 364 (Huddersfield) and 570/571 (Brighouse), from Hirst Wood to Shipley Market Place. Some Wrose was withdrawn journeys are extended to Bradford. Service 677 Bradford - Shipley via Crag Rpad is extended to Shipley Glen, Coach Road. Leaflets were issued to cover all this month's changes but there are write to an SAE.

Stand allocations in Shipley Market Place were altered to coincide with the introduction of the revised services.

Following termination of the Leeds/Bradford Airport Joint Committee's contractual payment for the running of the Leeds-Airport (X30) service, the route was withdrawn from Sunday 15th June.

4. OPERATING NOTES

Route 94 (Malton-Ovingham-Nunnington) is regularly worked by dual purpose Leyland Leopards, no doubt on "fill-in" turns.

1010(M) is the regular on Malton local 93.

The two Leyland National 2's at Bradford, 1501/4, have appeared on Bradford-Scarborough (43) during June/July; on 5th July the two Bradford duties were covered by 1504/1 respectively.

Following the service revisions on 22nd June and resulting transfers, the remaining Lodekkas were to all intents and purposes surplus although linensed to the end of the month. At Leeds, whilst 1804/13/5 may have been used on 23rd/24th June, they were out of use by the 25th and lined up in the depot yard by the 26th. Last routes were: 1804-670; 1813-741, 1815-795.

At. Bradford, 1788 was still in use on Manningham Lane on 25th June and on a School Special on Thursday morning 26th June. 1801 appears to have been taken out of use earlier than 1788, and it was in the depot yard by 27th June.

As usual, no reports have been received of operations at Keighley, and it is not known whether 1802 saw any use after 22nd June.

GENERAL NEWS

In a spectacular accident in the Headrow, Leeds, on 28th May, 2518 lost its entire back end when it was struck by a stolen Metro Leeds Atlantean. It was taken to the Body Shop where it received the back from withdrawn 2512, and had returned to service by 23rd June. It now has 2512's chrome rear bumper instead of the black fibreglass one previously fitted.

Further to the item in issue 350 regarding the Ferodo retarder fitted to 2350, 2345 of the same batch carries a Telma label on the rear mudflap, so 2350 may be the only Ferodo fitted example.
